Summary of Key Community Concerns by Town

CONCORDIA – WARD 1

Main Issues Raised:

- Lack of implementation of IDP priorities and projects.
 - Poor service delivery and limited municipal visibility.
 - Severe backlog in drain (sewer pit) extraction services.
 - Concerns regarding mining companies' compliance with permits and SLP commitments.
 - Dissatisfaction with administrative delays ("red tape").

VIOOLSDRIFT – WARD 2

Main Issues Raised:

- Dissatisfaction with ward councillor representation and communication.
 - Housing shortages and lack of housing development.
 - Cemetery expansion and maintenance required.
 - Poor road conditions and lack of road maintenance.
 - Insufficient job creation and development projects.
 - Lack of street lighting and public safety concerns.
 - Water and sanitation infrastructure upgrades needed.
 - Requests for improved community engagement and municipal feedback.

ROOIWAL – WARD 2

Main Issues Raised:

- Land ownership disputes and property administration concerns.
 - Poor service delivery.
 - Need for sustainable water supply.
 - Lack of street lighting.
 - Shortage of surveyed and serviced residential stands.
 - Concerns regarding municipal billing.
-

GOODHOUSE / HENKRIES – WARD 3

Main Issues Raised:

- Chronic water shortages and need for upgrades to water infrastructure.
 - Housing shortages and need for emergency housing.
 - Lack of street lighting and public safety concerns.
 - Land ownership and CPA-related disputes.
 - Insufficient communication and engagement from the municipality.
 - Need for sanitation improvements.
 - Poor road conditions and limited municipal services.
 - Need for improved waste removal and maintenance services.

ROOIWINKEL – WARD 3

Main Issues Raised:

- Need for surveyed and serviced residential stands.
 - Lack of street lighting.
 - Poor sanitation services and maintenance of public toilets.
 - Poor road maintenance.
 - Health concerns relating to water and sewer infrastructure.
 - Lack of recreational and sporting facilities.

BULLETRAP - WARD 3

Main Issues Raised:

- Lack of implementation of IDP projects.
 - Dissatisfaction with councillor visibility and communication.
 - Lack of street lighting.
 - Shortage of residential stands.
 - Poor sewer/drain extraction services.
 - Poor road maintenance.
 - Lack of economic development projects and employment opportunities.
 - Maintenance required on community facilities.

SPRINGBOK – WARD 4

Main Issues Raised:

- Water supply reliability and infrastructure challenges.
 - Poor road conditions and maintenance.
 - Need for improved communication and transparency from the municipality.
 - Concerns regarding municipal billing and debt recovery.
 - Deterioration of sports and community facilities.
 - Non-compliance with municipal by-laws and zoning regulations.

CAROLUSBERG – WARD 4

Main Issues Raised:

- Repairs and upgrades required for community facilities.
 - Poor road maintenance.
 - High demand for residential stands.
 - Stormwater management challenges.
 - Street and infrastructure maintenance concerns.
 - Illegal occupation and informal structures requiring intervention.

FONTEINTJIE – WARD 4

Main Issues Raised:

- Upgrading of water and sewer infrastructure.
 - Need for a new cemetery.
 - Poor telecommunications and cellular coverage.
 - Stormwater management requirements.
 - Lack of sports facilities.
 - Frequent water leaks and infrastructure maintenance concerns.
 - Illegal dumping and environmental management issues.

BERGSIG - WARD 5

Main Issues Raised:

- Demand for residential and economic development stands.
 - Road paving and maintenance requirements.
 - Stormwater infrastructure needed.
 - Street lighting maintenance.
 - Community hall repairs and upgrades.
 - Upgrading of municipal service points.
 - Waste management concerns.

OKIEP – WARD 6

Main Issues Raised:

- Residential stands are unaffordable for many residents.
 - Housing shortages.
 - Poor road maintenance and incomplete infrastructure projects.
 - Drain/sewer extraction services not functioning effectively.
 - Street lighting maintenance required.
 - Land administration and building restrictions on allocated properties.

MATJIESKLOOF – WARD 7

Main Issues Raised:

- Lack of implementation of IDP projects.
 - Shortage of residential stands.
 - Need for a new cemetery.
 - Sports facility upgrades.
 - Concerns regarding electricity tariffs.
-

VAALWATER – WARD 7

Main Issues Raised:

- No community concerns were recorded as no residents, or councillor attended the scheduled IDP and Budget Public Participation meeting.

KLEINZEE – WARD 8

Main Issues Raised:

- Severe and ongoing water supply crisis.
 - Poor communication and lack of feedback from municipal leadership.
 - Incorrect billing, valuations, and zoning concerns.
 - Poor road conditions.
 - Lack of medical services and emergency response.
 - Sewerage problems linked to water shortages.
 - Need for improved waste management.
 - Lack of transparency in IDP and municipal decision-making.

KOMAGGAS – WARD 8

Main Issues Raised:

- No community concerns were recorded as no residents, or councillor attended the scheduled IDP and Budget Public Participation meeting.

BUFFELSRIVIER – WARD 8

Main Issues Raised:

- No community concerns were recorded as no residents, or councillor attended the scheduled IDP and Budget Public Participation meeting.

NABABEEP – WARD 9

Main Issues Raised:

- Need for greater accountability regarding implementation of IDP priorities.
 - Concerns regarding municipal asset maintenance.
 - Stray animal management.
 - High unemployment and economic challenges.
 - Perceived inefficiencies in municipal workforce productivity.
 - Concerns regarding road maintenance materials and environmental safety.
 - Requests for clearer plans and solutions rather than repeated consultations.

OVERALL RECURRING THEMES ACROSS MOST COMMUNITIES

The following issues were repeatedly raised across multiple towns:

1. **Water Supply and Water Infrastructure**
2. **Housing Shortages and Residential Stands**
3. **Poor Road Maintenance and Upgrading**
4. **Street Lighting and Public Safety**
5. **Lack of Service Delivery**
6. **Poor Communication and Community Feedback**
7. **Failure to Implement IDP Priorities**
8. **Sanitation and Sewer Infrastructure Challenges**
9. **Job Creation and Economic Development**
10. **Maintenance of Community Facilities**
11. **Waste Management and Illegal Dumping**
12. **Land Administration and Property-Related Challenges**

These issues represent the highest-priority concerns consistently raised by communities throughout the Nama-Khoi Municipal area.
